Greg attended and graduated from Jefferson City High School, he then later served in the United States Army. He was the owner of Rollins Automotive for many years. He was an avid fisherman and enjoyed doing yard work. Greg was active in Calvary Lutheran High School and attended Trinity Lutheran Church. He was a member of the Wardsville Lions Club, Cole County Republican Club, Jefferson City Jaycees and on the board of Working Wheels 4 Working Families. Greg was voted the News Tribune Reader's Choice Award for #1 Auto Mechanic and #1 Auto Repair Shop for many years.
