R. Ward McKnight, 88, of Columbia, passed away on Monday, September 7, 2020 at the Neighborhoods in Columbia.

Ward was born on August 14, 1932 in Osage County, Missouri to the late Ted and Ioda (Thompson) McKnight. He graduated from Chamois High School. He served his country in the Air Force during the Korean War.

Ward McKnight began McKnight Tire in Jefferson City on July 1, 1963. One year later he expanded to Columbia, Missouri. The company is still in operation today. His hobbies included raising, riding and training Tennessee Walking Horses. He was also an avid hunter and outdoorsman.
